

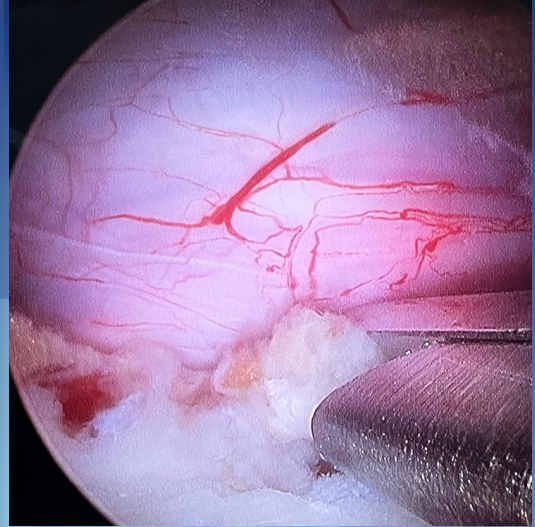

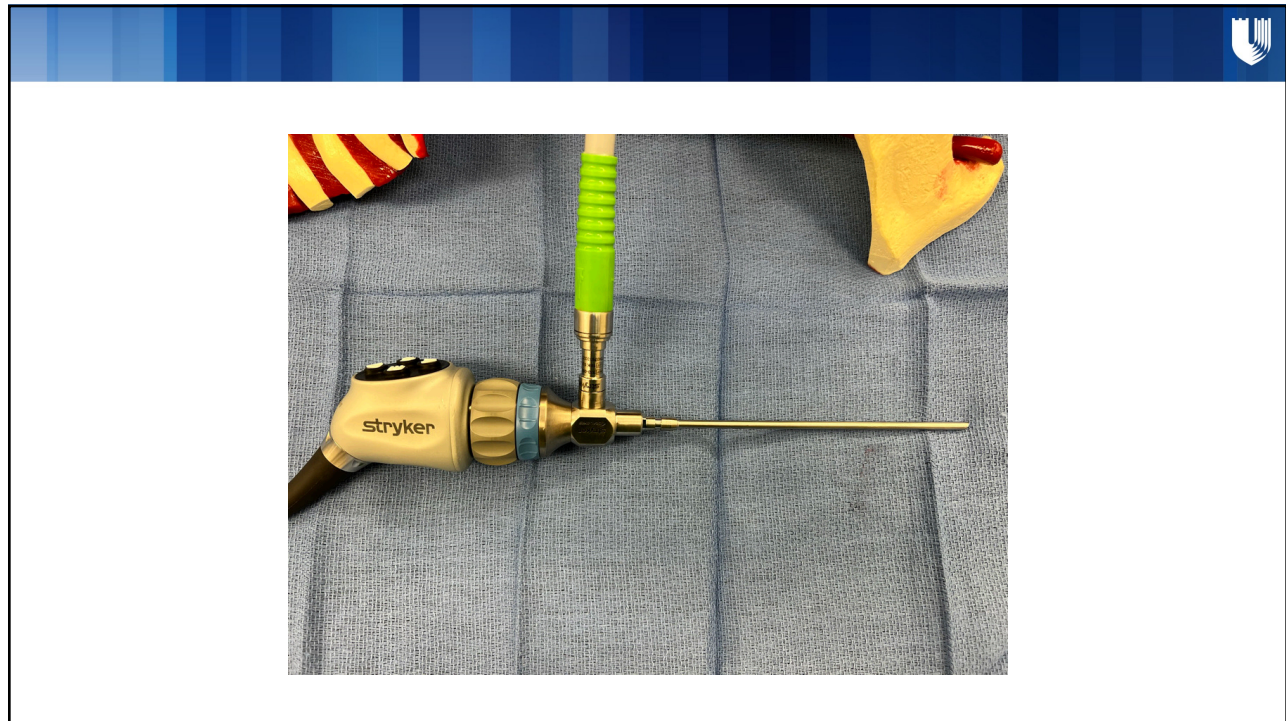

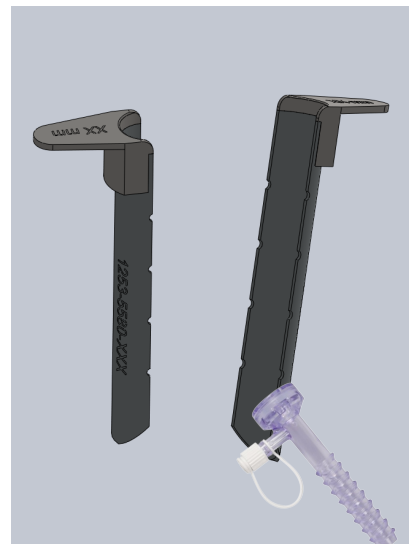


Water Pump – 30mm Hg

## Orientation / Setup

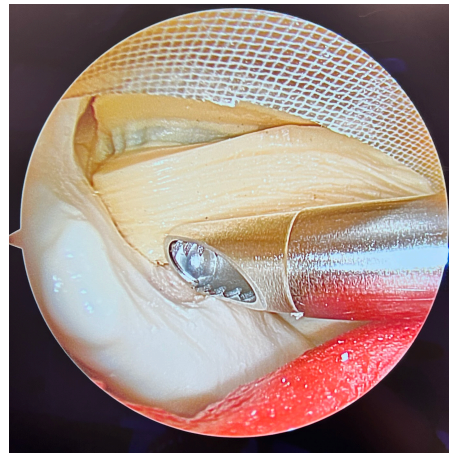
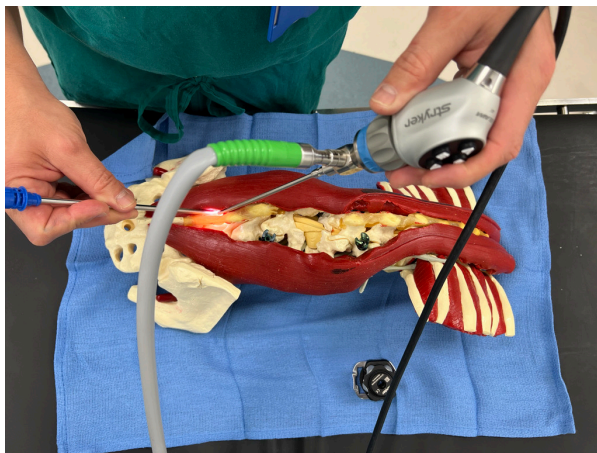
- Dexterity

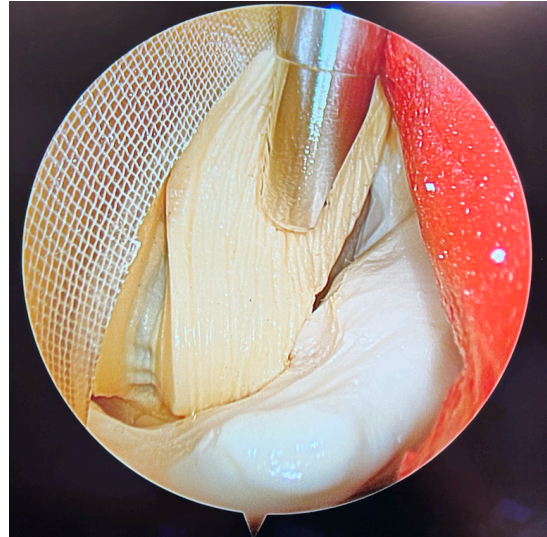
Left side of patient, camera cephalad, camera facing medially.

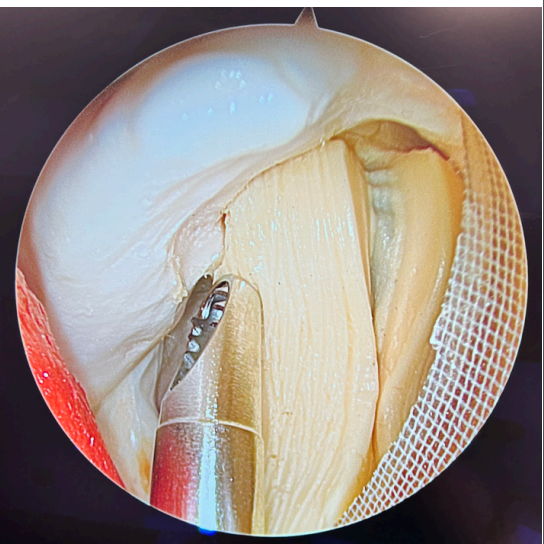
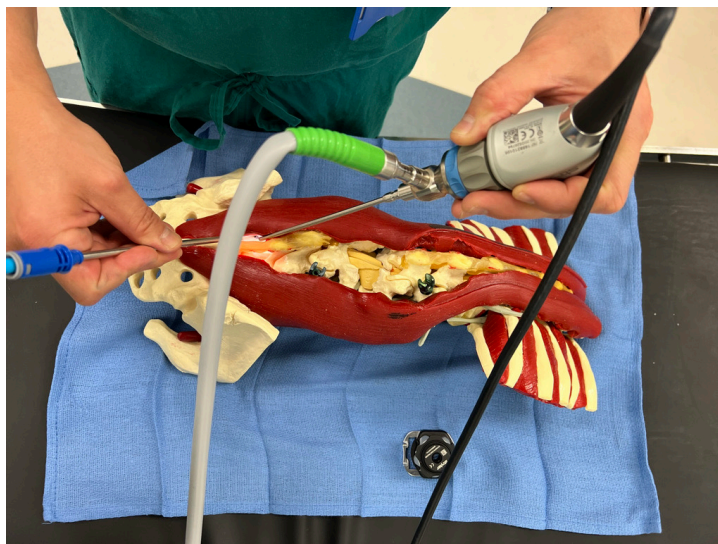
Left side of patient, camera cephalad, camera facing south.

Left side of patient, camera cephalad, camera facing north.

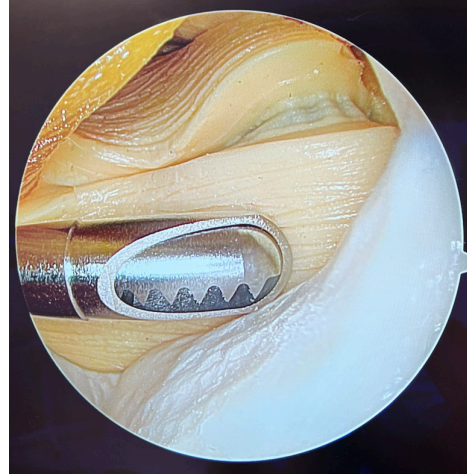
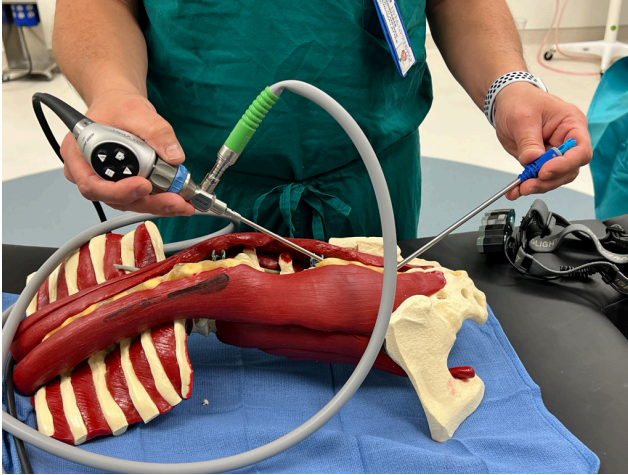

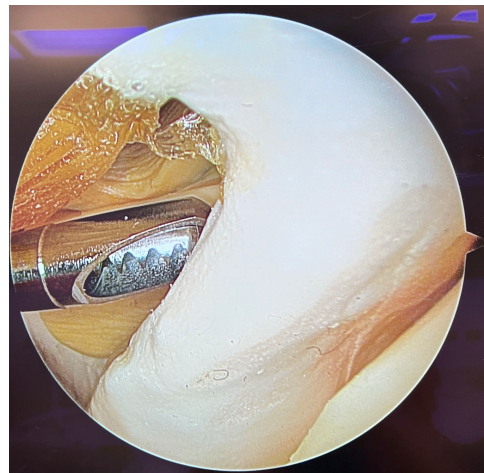
Right side of patient, camera cephalad, camera facing medial.
